1. Outline

In this assignment you will be completing 2 large maps of North America. These maps will include countries, provinces/territories/states and physical features. 2. Tips for this Assignment

i. International/Political Divisions

The international/political divisions are already separated on your map. All you need to do is label each section. All countries must be printed in capital letters. You may use abbreviations for states/provinces. After you are done labeling, you must lightly shade (with pencil crayon) each country.

ii. Physical Features

Not all physical features are present on your map. Either shade or draw in the feature for each item. You may want to use a legend. For example:
