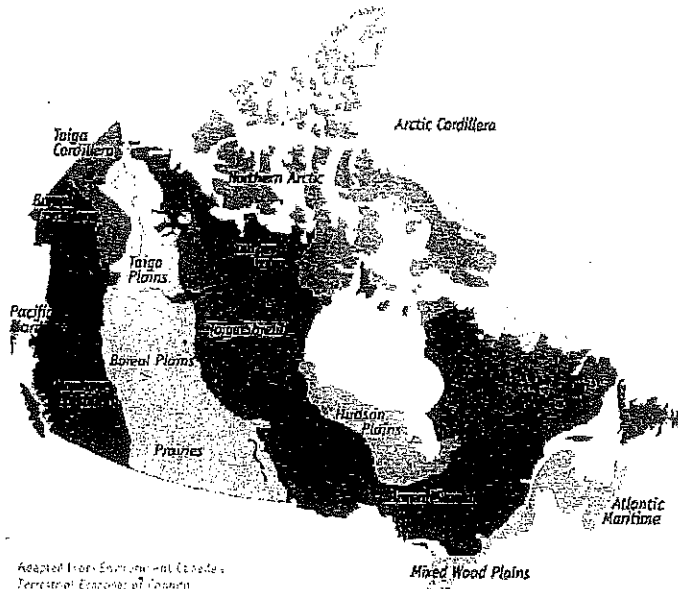

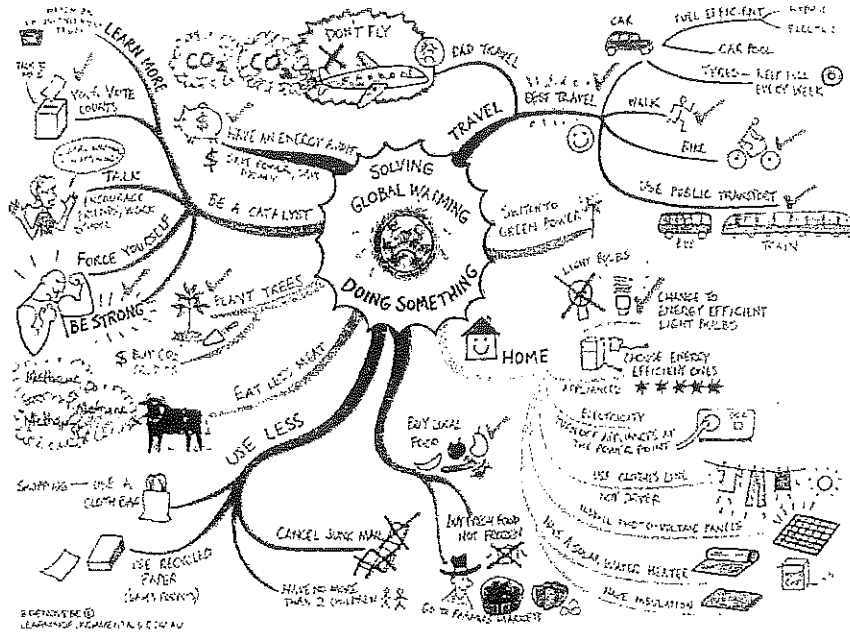

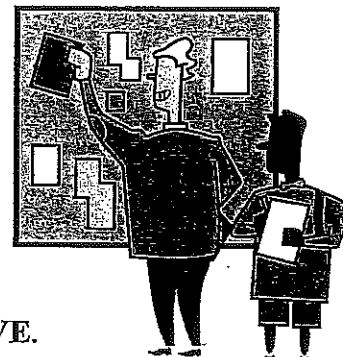
Infographics are new, creative ways to present information. Infographics channel information in a visually pleasing, instantly understandable manner, making it powerful and effective.



The Anatomy Of An Infographic 5 Steps To Creating A Powerful Visual

Anatomy of an Infographic:

1. Visual:
 - a. Colour Coding
 - b. Graphics
 - c. Reference Icons (✓ x)
2. Content:
 - a. Facts/Statistics
 - b. References
 - c. Deductions
